CTV: RED DOOR DINNER

The Red Door Dinner welcomes 80-100 of our downtown neighbors for dinner and fellowship each Wednesday from 5-6:00 p.m. Meals are prepared by volunteers in our licensed and inspected kitchen, per Health Code requirements. This is a ministry of love that is expressed by way of homecooked meals and a loving, supportive environment for our friends and neighbors.



Current Needs

Volunteers (individuals, families, groups) to prepare a meal for the Wednesday Dinner

- Depending on meal and experience with large-batch cooking, we recommend 2-4 people per week. Time commitment varies depending on meal, with 2-3 hours the norm. You are welcome to just cook or to stay and serve as well!

Thursday morning volunteers to return washed dishes to the pantry

- Per health code, washed dishes must air-dry. Volunteers needed to return the washed dishes to the pantry on one or more Thursday mornings. Commitment is less than one hour.

Training/Mentoring/Support

- Volunteers can select a main dish recipe from our recipe bank that has already been adapted to feed 120 guests. The salad and dessert are generally already covered unless you choose otherwise.
- Use food in the freezer when available, or purchase ingredients as needed. Casseroles are always a fan favorite!
- Kitchen training is always available and written kitchen and food safety information is provided.
- Experienced volunteers are available to assist as needed including scaling recipes and kitchen help.
- Food costs are all reimbursed! Just fill out a voucher, attach your receipts, and give to Meredith to sign and get processed.
