EDISON SCHOOL PROGRAM

Teachers at Edison Environmental Science Academy match volunteer skill sets and comfort level with student and classroom needs. Much of the volunteering involves one-on-one tutoring in reading, and math, though some have brought their dogs to listen to the children read. We also need monthly birthday treat volunteers. Our congregation provides school supplies, books as holiday gifts, staff luncheons, financial support of the 5th grade trip to Sherman Lake Camp, 5th grade graduation gift bags, and snacks for the after-school Art Club.



Current Needs

Per classroom: We are looking for at least one volunteer per classroom, to make a sustained commitment of attending a minimum of 1 hour per week (preferred) for the academic school year, allowing for flexibility for vacations, illness, bad roads, etc. An information packet is provided with a school calendar, introduction materials, and the name and contact information for the classroom teacher with whom you are volunteering. The time and activity are arranged with the teacher. No educational background is required. A background check is required.

Monthly Birthday Treats: Provide birthday treats to each classroom of 20-28 students once a month. To meet Health Department Requirements, treats must be purchased either pre-packaged, or from a commercial bakery.
