



OUTREACH HOPE GARDEN

Volunteers plant, weed, feed, harvest, and distribute produce grown on the Pine Island campus garden plot. An average of 4,000 pounds of produce were harvested over the past two years and donated to Loaves and Fishes and Mothers of Hope. Damaged produce is donated to Chubby Goat Acres – a farm animal rescue organization. Additionally, beehives produce honey for sale at the Christmas Bazaar, the proceeds of which support CTV.



Current Needs

We welcome new volunteers to complement our current crew.

Gardening and plot maintenance occurs between April and October. Tasks are suitable for adults, young people, and families. No gardening experience is required.

How we do it

During the season, we garden Monday, Wednesday and Friday 9:30 to 12:30. Volunteers need not attend all three days, and days/weeks off for vacations and family responsibilities are encouraged.

New volunteers will work with experienced volunteers and be able to learn as well as enjoy good conversation and a coffee/snack break.

Volunteers will need to have good, garden ready shoes and gloves. Hope Garden has all the tools needed. But – if you have a favorite tool, bring it.
