



SOUND AND VIDEO TEAM

Sound and Video volunteers work together to ensure Sunday and special services such as Christmas Eve and Good Friday, are recorded and streamed live for any who are unable or unsure of attending in person (1 person operating the sound board; 1 person operating the video console). Volunteers also operate the board for weddings, funerals, and other special events.



Current Needs

1-2 volunteers to be added to the volunteer rotation for Sunday services. Sound and/or video board experience is nice, but not necessary. Volunteers arrive by 9 a.m. on Sundays to set up microphones, perform sound checks, ready the system for live stream, and check cameras and shots. After service, volunteers collect microphones and break down and store equipment.

Training/Mentoring/Support

New volunteers will receive personal training sessions at the Church on the equipment. Once volunteers are comfortable, they will be added to the volunteer rotation. Schedules are published 3-4 months at a time, and adjustments can be made for schedule changes. The volunteers also work together to cover unexpected issues like illness, or the sudden need to travel to Stockholm to accept a Nobel Prize.



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
